Writing

-Children will practise forming the letters from their name using a variety of different materials.

-Children will be practising to write their name during every session.

- a losing story

- a finding story

Reading

-This half term we will be looking at lots of poems and books about 'ourselves' and 'families'.

### Personal, Social, Emotional

#### Development

- Children will be learning to self-select activities and use resources, with help when needed.
- Children will be introduced to Reception rules and routines, and increasingly be able to follow these.
- Children will be developing the ability to take turns with adults and other children in provision.

#### Communication

#### & Language

- Children will be practising a wide range of nursery rhymes and are encouraged to share these at home.
- Children will be encouraged to widen their vocabulary. Adults in setting will support this by encouraging children to speak in full sentences where possible.
- To use talk to connect ideas, explain what is happening and anticipate what might happen next.
- To use talk in pretending that objects stand for something else in play
- To encourage children to maintain attention and listen for short amounts of time, e.g. 5 minutes.

#### **Physical Development**

- To begin/refine a tripod pencil grip
- Children will be developing movement, balancing, throwing and catching skills.
- Children will be practising our scissor skills using one-handed tools and equipment



# Understanding the World

Design

There will be lots of opportunities for the children to use materials freely.

- Children will be supported to cut, stick and join materials in order to turn their ideas into models.
- Children will be encouraged to create large models in the ourdoor area.
- Children will be encouraged to create shelters by den building.

As a class. we will also explore a variety of instruments and talk about the different sounds that they make

#### Homework

- Children will receive a weekly home learning sheet which will allow you to share and continue their learning at home.
- Reading packs should be in school everyday.
- Children will receive home work linked to RWI sounds
- We encourage parents to read a variety of books and stories at home and create a healthy bedtime routine. Children can borrow books from school to share at home and these can be changed as often as desired.
